WORKING EQUITATION PHASES

There are three phases or tests at each Level that make up this Working Equitation competition - Flatwork, Ease of Handling, and Speed.

FLATWORK

Prescribed tests are ridden at each level and are designed to evaluate the horse and rider and to be an assistance in training. The movements at each level build upon movements of the previous level and coincide with the type and difficulty of movements expected in the Ease of Handling and Speed phases at the corresponding levels.

WENZ FW TESTS AUG 2025

Each movement of the test is given a numerical score between 0-10, and collective marks are given at the end for paces, impulsion, willing cooperation, the rider's position and effectiveness of aids.

EASE OF HANDLING

Obstacles are set up to simulate the difficulties encountered by a horse and rider in the field. The goal of this phase is to negotiate the obstacles with accuracy, ease, smoothness and balance.

Each obstacle is given a numerical score, and collective marks are given for transitions/navigation, paces, impulsion, willing cooperation, and the rider's position and effectiveness of aids, and a mark is also given for overall presentation.

Obstacles are numbered and are ridden in order.

SPEED

The obstacles as used in the Ease of Handling phase are ridden at speed with no evaluation of style or movement.

Individual scores are based on elapsed time through the obstacles with time penalties added for mishandled obstacles.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

EOH course walk will take place at least 45 minutes before the commencement of the Flat Work phase for the first level. Riders complete the Flat Work test, then immediately proceed to the EOH course, followed by the Speed Round.

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt (and confirmed payment).

Ponies may compete against horses in all classes.

Only one class may be entered per combination.

The EOH course map & event time table will be sent to competitors the week prior to the show.

TEAMS COMPETITION – Enter a Team of 3 riders from your club/area. Riders must be entered in at least 2 different levels (eg you may have 2 Prelim & 1 Novice, or 1 Prelim, 1 Novice & 1 Elementary etc). Scores for the 3 riders will be averaged and placings calculated. Special awards will be given for Team Presentation; Team Spirit; and Best Team Name. Note Team name on your individual entry forms.
